Camp Sunrise and Sidekicks Updates:

Summer Camp 2022

After being on hold due to COVID, we were finally able to hold Camp Sunrise and Camp Sidekicks in-person this past July. They were a huge success and a much needed relief for the pediatric cancer fighters and their siblings. Thanks to our medical team and staff, campers and families for following our COVID protocols— we can proudly report that there were **NO** COVID cases reported at check-in, during or directly after the camps.



For the first time, we held camps at Whispering Hope Ranch located in the beautiful Payson, Arizona. Whispering Hope Ranch has 45 acres of cool pine trees and is already set up to accommodate the physical, emotional and developmental needs of our campers. The location proved to be better than anyone could have anticipated and we're looking forward to continuing our partnership with Whispering Hope Ranch. SWKCF also partnered with Children's Cancer Network (CCN) to provide summer day camp to our campers who couldn't join us in Payson. Thanks to CCN for supporting our campers and we're looking forward to next year.

Summer Camp 2023

The upcoming 6-day Summer Camps for 2023 will again be at the Whispering Hope Ranch in Payson, Arizona. Camp Sidekicks will run from June 25th to June 30th, with volunteers scheduled to arrive on June 24th. Camp Sunrise will run from July 2nd to July 7th, with those volunteers scheduled to arrive on July 1st. Additional details and registration information to come in the Spring of 2023.

Camp Activities Update

The Board continues to look for opportunities to expand activities for SWKCF campers and their families. We're excited to expand our partnerships with current and new organizations that support pediatric cancer patients, survivors and their siblings to increase engagement and impact.
